<i>Parent Communication</i> 12. Teachers will generate a progress report for students and parents every three weeks.		
<i>Academic Coaching</i> Teachers will identify “at –risk” students at the three week mark and contact parents to convey the need for and the availability of remediation.		
<i>Curriculum Alignment and Pacing</i> 2. Each teacher on the TPAI Teacher Evaluation Instrument or a teacher identified by the administration will submit weekly lesson plans to the administration. Career teachers must have lesson plans available upon request.	Monday of each week	Teachers

<i>Personalized Education Plans</i> 2. Counselors, Teachers, and CARE Team members will work to develop PEP’s for students with the following parameters: Parent Contact must be made, parent/students/teacher and one CARE Team member will meet to discuss the students progress and determine strategies to help students succeed academically. 3. PEP progress reviews will be monitored by the CARE Team and adjusted per grading period. Care Team will maintain file of current PEP’s 4.
