- Plans to create a SS, SC and Specials Area team of teachers to tackle subject specific curriculum for 2021-2022.

- Invitations sent home on April 26
- Session 1: June 7th-June 25th

- 150+ hours of instruction
- In-person instruction for end-of-course subjects
- Access to modules and teacher support for credit recovery courses necessary to meet graduation requirements
- In-person instruction for an elective course
- SEL support
