For the past four years we have had an international exchange program with a high school in Hobro, Denmark. In 2013 and in 2015, the students from Hobro came to visit BHS. They stayed with host families, attended school, and explored western North Carolina. In 2014, four teachers (Ashley Dickson, Sara Plum, Jane Fuller, and Jeremy Gibbs) and sixteen BHS students traveled to Hobro to stay with host families, attend school, explore local areas and historical sites.

It has all been a tremendous success, both academically and culturally. We would love to have the opportunity to continue this exchange by traveling to Denmark this spring. We would like to travel with a maximum of twenty BHS students who have been involved in the exchange over the past few years. The students are very eager to learn more about the Danish culture.
