The TCS dropout rate has dropped 48.8% since the 2003-2004 school year. TCS started focused efforts on increasing graduation rates and decreasing dropout rates in the 2004-05 school year. The TCS dropout rate has dropped by 61% since the district's historical high in the 2007-08 school year.

<u>Definition of a Dropout:</u> A dropout is a student who was enrolled at any point in the prior year but who is not enrolled by the 20th day of the reporting year. Dropouts do not include students who graduate, move out of the country, enroll in another education program out of the school system, or children who are deceased. Students who enroll in a GED program are dropouts.

General Observations:

- TCS had 24 high school dropouts and no middle school dropout. This is the lowest percentage rate in the last 22 years (as long as we have records).
- This represents a 25% decrease in the number of dropouts from last year. Dropouts have decreased by 61% in since 2007.
- Approximately 50% of dropouts did not spend all their schooling in TCS.
- Common withdrawal reasons include lack of engagement (5), interest in a GED (7), and not returning after a long term suspension (3). Only 1 cited the need to work as a primary reason.
