Purpose of Title Allotments:



- **Title I-** Title I is designed to provide all children significant opportunity to receive a fair, equitable, and high-quality education, and to close educational achievement gaps.
- **Title II-** Preparing, Training, and Recruiting High Quality Teachers and Principals. To increase student academic achievement through strategies such as improving teacher and principal quality and increasing the number of highly qualified teachers in the classroom and highly qualified principals and assistant principals in schools; and hold local educational agencies and schools accountable for improvements in student academic achievement.
- **Title III-** to help ensure that children who are limited English proficient, and meet the same challenging State academic content and student academic achievement standards as all children are expected to meet;) to develop high-quality language instruction.
- **Title IV-** 3 areas: well rounded education, support safe and healthy students, effective use of technology

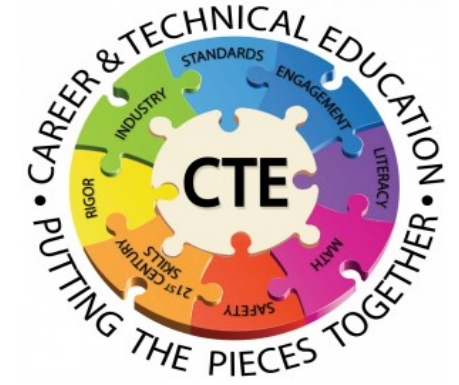
Elementary and Secondary Schools

- ESSER II: \$3.2- summer school, 14 allowable uses
- ESSER III: \$7.3 with 20% (\$1.4) mandated to go towards learning gaps and 12 allowable uses
- *These funds are not allowed to be used for projects that had been in the planning process prior to Covid.*
