

STUDENT LONG-TERM SUSPENSION

The principal, with the prior approval of the Superintendent, shall have the authority to suspend for a period in excess of ten school days but not exceeding the time remaining in the school year, any student who willfully violates the policies of conduct established by the Board of Education. The student or his parent(s)/guardian(s) may appeal the decision of the principal to the Board of Education.
