We develop resources for youth in the county, and working to combat the most recent drug epidemic of E-Cigarette abuse.



E-Cigarette Facts

- CONTRARY TO POPULAR BELIEF (among students)
 - E-Cigarettes contain at least as much nicotine as tobacco cigarettes
 - E-Cigarette vapor is aerosol, NOT water vapor
 - E-Cigarette manufacturers are NOT required to disclose harmful ingredients



E-Cigarette Use In Schools

- In North Carolina, 1 in 7 high schoolers uses E-Cigarettes
- There has been an 894% increase in E-Cigarette usage in High Schools from 2011 to 2017
- Tobacco use in youth is rising from 1.2% to 28.8% based on the 2017
 NC Youth Tobacco Survey
- In NC, there's no legal age for possession, but use is illegal under the age
 18
 - However, E-Cigarettes are banned from school as a part of a tobacco-free campus



C-Stop

- A suspension program implemented last year to combat E-Cigarette abuse
- Effects of C-Stop:
 - C-Stop sessions goes on a student's permanent record forever
 - C-Stop doesn't offer any help for nicotine addiction
 - Isolates addicted teens
- Future of C-Stop
 - Davidson River shutting down in
- C-Stop hasn't decreased use
