

- This question does not apply since my child is currently enrolled in the Online Learning Path.




Note:





- Remain in the Online Learning Path (remote learning at home all week)




Note:


- Current Online Learning Path: My child will stay enrolled in the OLP for the rest of the school year.

If Plan A is selected, what date would be best to transition?




- Earliest possible date (October 5)

- Beginning of second semester (January 7)




If Plan A (full capacity in grades K-5) was selected by the Board of Education, what date do you feel would be best to transition for your child? 524 responses (125 OLP)
