## **Election of Officers**

N.C.G.S. § 115C-41 requires all local boards of education to have an organizational meeting no later than 60 days after the swearing in of members following election or appointment. At the organizational meeting, the members of all boards shall elect one or their members as chairman for a period of one year, or until his successor is elected and qualified. The Transylvania

County Board of Education has traditionally elected a chair and vice chair every year at its first meeting in December.

Vice Chairman Dalton asked Board Attorney Chris Campbell to lead the election of officers. Mr. Campbell reviewed the process with the board, then opened the floor for nominations for board chair. MR. COCHRAN NOMINATED TANYA DALTON AS BOARD CHAIR. There were no other nominations. Mr. Campbell closed nominations and asked for a vote. ON A UNANIMOUS VOTE, Tanya Dalton was elected as board chair for the next year. Mr. Campbell opened the floor for nominations for board vice chair. MR. LAMBERT NOMINATED GREG COCHRAN AS BOARD VICE CHAIR. There were no other nominations. Mr. Campbell closed nominations and asked for a vote. ON A UNANIMOUS VOTE, Greg Cochran was elected as board vice chair for the next year. Mr. Campbell returned the meeting to Mrs. Dalton.

Superintendent Lisa Fletcher introduced new Chief Finance Officer Michelle Mullinax to the board.

Chairman Dalton called for a short recess at 6:10 p.m. The meeting reconvened at 6:15 p.m.

## **Board Member Training**

Board Attorney Chris Campbell gave a training session on school board member rights and responsibilities. Topics included, but were not limited to, legal considerations and best practices, roles and duties of members, public records, confidential information, public comment, social media, closed sessions, complaints and concerns, disagreements among members, "information" v. studies or research, setting meeting agendas, school visits, budget review and qualified immunity. Mr. Campbell emphasized that trust is key--trust in the law, trust in each other, and trust in the superintendent and administration.

There was no further business, and ON A MOTION BY MR. WIENER, SECONDED BY MR. COCHRAN, the meeting was adjourned at 7:54 p.m.
