

**Minutes  
Transylvania County Board of Education  
May 6, 2023 and May 8, 2023**

**May 6, 2023**

The Transylvania County Board of Education held a special called meeting on Saturday, May 6, 2023 at 9:00 a.m. in the Patton Building at Blue Ridge Community College, Flat Rock, NC. The following board members were present: Tawny McCoy, Chair; Kimsey Jackson, Vice Chair; Tanya Dalton; Ron Kiviniemi; and Chris Wiener. Board Attorney Kris Caudle was also in attendance. Chairman McCoy called the meeting to order.

MRS. MCCOY MOVED that the board go into closed session pursuant to G.S. § 143-318.11 subsection (a)(1) to consider confidential personnel matters protected by G.S. § 115C-319-321; subsection (a)(3) to consider matters covered by the attorney-client privilege; and (a)(6) to consider the qualifications for initial employment of a public officer or official. MR. KIVINIEMI SECONDED and the motion passed unanimously at approximately 9:05 a.m. The five board members and Mr. Caudle were present in the closed session.
