The NC School Boards Association’s Board of Directors (BOD) invites each local school board to **nominate one** of its members to serve on NCSBA’s Legislative Committee. This individual should be nominated through a vote of the full board taken in open session and submitted by March 22, 2024.

This Committee’s primary task is to develop the draft NCSBA Legislative Agenda for consideration and adoption by the Delegate Assembly. The committee is comprised of a subset of the NCSBA BOD and at-large members. The NCSBA President will appoint one at-large member from each of the eight education regions to serve a two-year term. Remember, the NCSBA Legislative Agenda is your legislative agenda, and this process provides an opportunity for the larger membership to become more directly involved.

It is critical that your board’s nominee is able to attend the following meetings:

- Friday, July 19, 2024, 11:00 am to 3:00 pm, in person. The Committee will review the prior agenda and develop the survey for the upcoming two-year agenda.
- Friday, September 13, 2024, 11:00 am to 3:00 pm, in person. The Committee will discuss/analyze the survey results and craft the agenda.
- 3rd meeting virtually – TBD. The Committee will review and approve the draft 2024-2025 NCSBA Legislative Agenda.

The two in-person meetings will be held at the NCSBA office building in Raleigh; NCSBA will reimburse mileage to and from Raleigh and provide lunch. There may also be specially called meetings, dependent upon legislative developments.
