43 44 If not already revised by insurance or through its participation in the North Carolina School Boards Trust, the Transylvania County Board of Education (the "board") shall provide a cost of defense defend, hold harmless, and indemnify for the current board members, former board members, the current superintendent, and/or former superintendents from any and all demands, claims, suits, actions, and legal proceedings brought against the board or the superintendent in their individual capacities, or in their capacities as agents and employees of the board, provided the incident giving rise to any such demand, claim, suit, action or legal proceeding arises pursuant to the scope of their duties. The defense shall be provided by the board's own counsel or by employing separate legal counsel.

- A. The board shall provide for the defense of any civil or criminal action or proceeding brought against any current or former member of the board or any current or former superintendent brought against him or her in either his or her official or individual capacity, or both, on account of any act done or omission made, or any act allegedly done or omission allegedly made, in the scope and course of his or her duty as a member of the Transylvania County Board of Education or as superintendent of the Transylvania County Schools. The defense shall be provided by the board by its own counsel, or by employing other counsel, or by purchasing insurance which requires that the insurer provide the defense.
- B. The board shall budget funds for the purpose of paying all of a claim made or any civil iudgment entered against any of its current or former members or any current or former superintendent when such claim is made or such judgment is rendered as damages on account of any act done or omission made, or any act allegedly done or omission allegedly made, in the scope and course of his or her duty as a member of the Transylvania County Board of Education or as superintendent of the Transylvania County Schools. This policy shall not apply if the board finds that such current or former member or any current or former superintendent acted or failed to act because of actual fraud, corruption, or actual malice on her or her part.

The board may budget for and purchase insurance coverage for payment of claims or iudgments pursuant to this policy.

C. Section B of this policy shall not authorize the board to pay all or part of a claim made or civil judgment entered or to provide a defense to a criminal charge unless notice of the claim or litigation is given to the board prior to the time that the claim is settled or civil iudgment is entered.
