

1 ~~Board members~~ Members of the Transylvania County Board of Education (the “board”) are encouraged
2 to participate in school board development activities designed for them. New board members
3 will have the opportunity and will be encouraged to attend orientation programs for new board
4 members sponsored by the state and national school board associations. It is the responsibility of
5 the board to provide new board members with a thorough orientation to board policies, practices,
6 and duties.

7
8 Each board member must fulfill the legal requirement to receive a minimum of 12 hours of
9 training annually.

10
11 All board members must receive a minimum of two hours of ethics education within 12 months
12 after initial election or appointment to office and again within 12 months after each subsequent
13 election or appointment to office. This education must address the laws and principles that
14 govern conflicts of interest and ethical standards for local government officials. The
15 superintendent shall maintain records verifying that each board member has participated in the
16 required ethics education. The ethics education required under this paragraph may be counted
17 towards the annual 12-hour training requirement.

19 Unless otherwise approved by the board, such training must be provided by the following
20 entities: the school system, the North Carolina School Boards Association, the National School
21 Boards Association, the School of Government, or the Department of Public Instruction. If a
22 board member wishes to receive training credit or be reimbursed for attending training offered by
23 another entity, he or she must obtain approval from the board.

25 Funds for participation will be budgeted annually, and reimbursement for expenses will be made
26 in accordance with law and applicable board policy.
