

1 Employees and ~~board~~ members of the Transylvania County Board of Education (the “board”)
2 have an absolute duty to maintain the confidentiality of records as required by law. Employees
3 and board members, by the nature of their positions, are exposed to confidential information that
4 should not be repeated or discussed except with those recognized by law as having a right to the
5 information. Any employee or board member who is not sure whether particular information
6 may be protected by state or federal confidentiality laws should seek clarification from his or her
7 immediate supervisor or the ~~assistant superintendent for~~ director of human resources (for
8 employees) or from the superintendent or board attorney (for board members). When violations
9 occur, appropriate disciplinary action will be taken.

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11 It is a criminal violation for an employee or board member to do either of the following:

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13 • Knowingly, willfully, and with malice permit any unauthorized person to have access to
14 information contained in a personnel file, or
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- 16 • Knowingly and willfully examine, remove, or copy a personnel file that he or she is not
17 specifically authorized to access pursuant to G.S. 115C-321.
