

1 The Transylvania County Board of Education (the “board”) reserves to itself the functions of
2 developing, revising, and rescinding policies for the school system. The formation and adoption
3 of policies will constitute the primary method through which the board exercises its leadership in
4 the operation of the school system. All policy decisions will be made while keeping in mind the
5 board’s objective to provide students with the opportunity to receive a sound basic education.

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7 Board policy is applicable to all schools and programs within the school system unless (1) the
8 board directs otherwise in an individual policy or (2) the board grants a school a waiver
9 requested under policy 3430, School Improvement Plan. ~~However~~ In addition, unless otherwise
10 directed by the board, the superintendent may exempt any school designated as a restart model
11 authorized by G.S. 115C-105.37B(a)(2) from any board policy requirements that correspond to a
12 state statute or rule from which restart schools are exempted by law.
