

1 The Transylvania County Board of Education (the “board”) recognizes that online instruction is
2 a valuable tool for affording students extended educational options. The board will provide
3 opportunities for students to participate in online instruction to the extent that it is academically
4 and financially prudent.
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6 School guidance counselors shall advise students on North Carolina Virtual Public School
7 courses and other online courses available for credit. Enrollment in an online for credit course
8 will count toward satisfying board requirements related to minimum instructional days, seat time
9 policies, student attendance, and athletic and/or extracurricular obligations.
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11 A student, with the principal’s prior approval, may enroll in an online course with assistance
12 from the school e-learning advisor. The principal shall designate a guidance counselor at the
13 school to serve as the e-learning advisor, who will be responsible for coordinating the enrollment
14 of students in online courses, monitoring students’ progress in those courses, and supervising any
15 required testing. In addition, the principal shall ensure that the e-learning advisor implements a
16 plan for supporting credit recovery students throughout the semester.
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18 The superintendent shall develop regulations consistent with State Board of Education
19 requirements and this policy for students enrolling in online instruction.
