

1 The [Transylvania County Board of Education \(the “board”\)](#) is committed to securing the future
2 of democracy by preparing young people to be educated, engaged voters. Further, the board is
3 committed to working in collaboration with the local board of elections to encourage students to
4 register to vote as permitted by North Carolina law.
5

6 In keeping with this commitment, the board directs the superintendent to establish a committee
7 of high school social studies teachers and other appropriate school personnel to collaborate with
8 the local board of elections to facilitate and encourage voter registration at all high schools in the
9 school system.

11 In compliance with G.S. 163-82.23, the principal of each high school shall make available to all
12 students and others who are eligible to register to vote the application forms described in G.S.
13 163-82.3.
