1 Disciplinary actions for students identified as exceptional children according to North Carolina
2 guidelines will conform to *Policies Governing Services for Children with Disabilities* as adopted
3 by the State Board of Education. If the *Policies Governing Services for Children with*
4 *Disabilities* manual does not fully address a particular issue, the director of exceptional children
5 will develop any necessary protocols consistent with state and federal law.
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7 All students with disabilities will be accorded all rights as provided by state and federal law. See
