1 The Transylvania County Board of Education (the "board") recognizes that the public schools 2 are an integral part of the community and that the public has a vested interest in having students 3 develop into productive members of the workforce and of society. The board encourages the 4 community to be involved in the school system and to assist the school system in the goal of 5 providing every student with the opportunity to receive a sound basic education. 6 7 Each year the board will ensure that the report card issued for the school system by the State 8 Board of Education receives widespread distribution to the local press or to other local channels 9 of news and information. In addition, the school system shall will publish on its website all 10 information required by law, including assessment and performance information and information on how state funds have been used to address local educational priorities. 11 12 13 **POLICIES** A. 14 In making policy decisions, the board will keep in mind its commitment to providing all 15 16 students in our community the opportunity to obtain a sound basic education. 17 The board's commitment to the wider community is expressed in various policies that 18 19 address the relationship between the school system and the community, such as: 20 21 1. Parental Involvement (policy 1310/4002); 22 23 Title I Parent and Family Engagement (policy 1320/3560); 2. 24 25 3. Public Records – Retention, Release, and Disposition (policy 5070/7350); 26 27 School Volunteers (policy 5015); 4. 28 29 5. Compliance with the Open Meetings Law (policy 2320); 30 31 6. Registered Sex Offenders (policy 5022); 32 33 7. Distribution and Display of Non-School Material (policy 5210); 34 35 8. Community Use of Facilities (policy 5030); and 36 37 9. Visitors to the Schools (policy 5020). 38 39 **B**. SCHOOL ADMINISTRATORS 40 41 School administrators shall: 42 43 1. demonstrate a commitment to working with the community; 44
