Any budget amendments made by the board must comply with the legal requirements for adopting the budget resolution and must be entered in the minutes of the board meeting. As required by G.S. 115C-433 (b) and (d), the board will obtain the permission of the county commissioners for certain budget amendments or transfers that affect the capital outlay fund or that increase or decrease the amount of an appropriation by more than 25 percent (or other percentage not less than 10 percent, if so specified in the board's budget resolution).

The Transylvania County Board of Education (the "board") recognizes that unexpected changes

in the financial resources and needs of the school district may occur after adoption of the budget

resolution. As necessary, the board will amend the budget resolution at any time after its

TRANSFERS BY THE SUPERINTENDENT

As necessary and by appropriate resolution, the board may authorize the superintendent to transfer funds from one appropriation to another within the same fund, subject to such limitations and procedures as may be prescribed by the board or state or federal law or regulations. Any such transfers shall be reported to the board at its next regular meeting and shall be entered in the minutes.
