

1 Public schools may receive Medicaid funds for some health services provided to students at
2 school. The services must be medically necessary and the student must be eligible for Medicaid
3 and special education. In North Carolina, the following services may be reimbursed in schools:

- 5 • Audiology
- 6 • Nursing services
- 7 • Occupational therapy
- 8 • Physical therapy
- 9 • Psychological/counseling services
- 10 • Speech-language pathology services

12 Transylvania County Schools will participate in the Medicaid program for reimbursement of
13 services as outlined by the North Carolina Department of Public Instruction. The superintendent
14 or superintendent’s designee may contract with a third-party vendor to assist with the billing
15 process if needed. Transylvania County Schools shall obtain parent permission prior to billing
16 for the reimbursement of services.
