Public schools may receive Medicaid funds for some health services provided to students at school. The services must be medically necessary and the student must be eligible for Medicaid and special education. In North Carolina, the following services may be reimbursed in schools:

- Audiology
 - Nursing services
 - Occupational therapy
 - Physical therapy
 - Psychological/counseling services
 - Speech-language pathology services

Transylvania County Schools will participate in the Medicaid program for reimbursement of services as outlined by the North Carolina Department of Public Instruction. The superintendent or superintendent's designee may contract with a third-party vendor to assist with the billing process if needed. Transylvania County Schools shall obtain parent permission prior to billing for the reimbursement of services.
