

STUDENT FUND RAISING ACTIVITIES

The Transylvania County Board of Education believes that the primary educational objectives of the schools are generally not compatible with the use of student organizations or individual students in fund raising activities. Fund raising projects by parent-teacher organizations are permitted in all schools as an expression of community support. These projects at the elementary school level are not to involve students as solicitors of funds. At the middle and high school levels parent-teacher organizations, band parents, athletic booster organizations, and other similar school related groups are to cooperate with the school principal to the extent that fund raising activities do not interfere with the school program.

Middle and high school student organizations may sponsor and conduct one fund raising event annually as approved by the school principal. In planning these activities, consideration must be given to the disrupting influence upon the school and the reputation of the school within the community.

Project activities, with the exception of orientation for middle and high school groups, shall not occur during the normal instructional schedule for students.
