104		Transylvania County Schools is not responsible for personal websites or

106		or organizations. Personal websites or web pages are not considered
107		system-related websites or web pages and are not covered by the

109		websites, please see policy IIBG, "Technology Acceptable Use.")

111		The Superintendent may use any means available to request the removal
112		of personal websites or web pages that substantially disrupt the school
113		environment or that utilize school district or individual school names,
114		logos, or trademarks without permission.

118		Website content must be kept current and be maintained regularly. All system-
119		related websites must include the name of the web page author, the date produced
120		or revised, and the e-mail address of the author. The Superintendent or designee

127		No information or graphics may be posted on websites in violation of any
128		copyright laws or policy IIAB, "Copyright Compliance." Copyright permission
129		must be obtained for the use of any copyrighted material unless use is permitted

131		principal or designee is responsible for maintaining copies of permission granted
132		for the use of copyrighted material.

141			hyperlink to the home page of the school district's official website. In
142			addition, all system-related websites must include a link to this policy and

147			The Superintendent and designee have editorial control over and
148			responsibility for the linking of a system-related website to other sites on
149			the Internet that are appropriate to the mission of the school district. Links
150			to external sites (including externally hosted teacher classroom sites) must
151			be approved by the principal. If required, web managers must obtain
152			permission from external websites before links are established from any
153			system-related website to external websites. To the extent possible, school
154			personnel shall determine the extent to which a secondary site is linked to
155			other sites on the Internet and whether such sites are appropriate for access
156			through school system websites. Web managers shall periodically check
157			external links for accuracy and appropriateness of content. School
158			employees must report any inappropriate links to the web manager.

160			Since the school district cannot control the content of other sites on the
161			Internet and their linkages, the following statement of disclaimer must be
162			inserted in a prominent position on the school district's official website, on
163			each school's official website, and on other system-related websites that
164			contain links to other websites or web pages that are not system-related
165			websites:

167			Transylvania County Schools retains control over what links will
168			be placed on system-related websites; however, the linked sites
169			themselves are not under the control of the Transylvania County
170			Board of Education, its agents, or its employees. The school
171			district is not responsible for the contents of any linked site, any
172			link contained in a linked site, or any changes or updates to such
173			sites. The school district provides links as a convenience, and the
174			inclusion of any link does not imply endorsement of the site by the
175			school district. The school district reserves the right to remove or
176			restrict any links appearing on sites under its operation.

205			school web pages. To protect the safety of students and employees, the following
206			precautions must be taken:

208			a. Neither home addresses nor telephone numbers will be listed;

210			b. Student e-mail addresses will not be listed; and,

212			c. Photographs of students and student work may be published on school
213			web pages unless a parent request for non-publication of those materials
214			has been submitted to the principal. Publication of photographs and/or
215			student work will include only the student's first name, with no other

218			The principal or designee is responsible for maintaining records of permission

221		3.	To protect a student's rights regarding his or her intellectual property, if a school
