Students in Transylvania County Schools shall earn grades based on academic progress. Behavioral and social skills shall receive grades at the elementary level.

Students in kindergarten will receive grades of M (Most of the Time), S (Some of the Time), and N (Not Yet).

Students is first and second grades will receive grades of 4 (Exceptional Progress), 3 (Progressing Steadily), 2 (Successful with Adult Help), 1 (Needs Attention), or Not Expectedat this Time.

Students in other elementary school grades will receive academic grades based on a 100%system with below 70% considered failing. Behavioral and social development will be graded as O (Outstanding), S (Satisfactory), U (Not Satisfactory), N (Needs Improvement), and NA-(Not Applicable).

Students in middle and high schools will receive only academic grades based on a 100% systemwith below 70% considered failing.

Additional comments or information may be attached to a student's report card at the teachers' or principals' discretion.

Report cards will be uniform throughout Transylvania County Schools.
