

INTERROGATIONS OF STUDENTS

The Transylvania County Board of Education will not prohibit law enforcement agents from attempting to question students at school if any of the following conditions exist:

- 1. Parental consent
- A court order involving the student(s)
- 3. A warrant involving the student(s)

Any of the three stated conditions provide sufficient justification for law enforcement agents to escort students to other locations for questioning. Should a law enforcement agent enter the principal's office with a court order or warrant for a student, reasonable efforts should be made to contact the parents if they have not been previously notified.
