DUAL ENROLLMENT IN HIGH SCHOOLS AND COMMUNITY COLLEGES/TECHNICAL INSTITUTES

FILE: LEC-E()

Under the provisions of the North Carolina State Administrative Code (4C.0300) high school students, under certain conditions, may be admitted to technical institutes and community colleges. The relevant part of 4C.0300 is as follows:

- (d) Selected high school students may be admitted to appropriate courses in a technical institute or community college under the following conditions:
  - (1) Require approval of the local board of trustees and the local board of education upon recommendation by the community college/technical institute president and the school superintendent.
  - (2) Restrict participation to students 16 years of age and older upon the initiation of such action by the public school.
  - (3) Require joint approval of individual student programs by the principal of the secondary school and the admissions office of the community college/technical institute.
  - (4) In order for a high school student to enroll concurrently in a community college/technical institute, that student must be taking at least three courses at his/her high school and be making appropriate progress toward graduation as determined by the school principal.
  - (5) High school students shall not displace adults but will be permitted to fill in as space permits. Classes at community colleges/technical institutes shall not be started solely for high school students. Once admitted, however, they should be treated as all other students.
  - (6) A community college or technical institute may approve the enrollment of high school students only when no more than five percent of the enrollment from that high school is or has been enrolled in the community college system during the regular ten month public school year. Exceptions to this maximum will require approval of the State Superintendent of Public Instruction and the President of the community college system.

- (7) High school students sixteen years old or older, upon the recommendation of the superintendent and the principal, may seek admission to a community college or technical institute during the summer quarter. These students may be admitted when a need for the instruction has been demonstrated and space is available.
- (8) High school students will pay regular tuition and fees.
