DUAL ENROLLMENT IN HIGH SCHOOLS AND
COMMUNITY COLLEGES/TECHNICAL INSTITUTES

Procedures

1. Approval of a student's application to enroll in course work at Community Colleges/Technical Institutes rests solely with the principal of the student's high school.
2. Acceptance for enrollment at Community Colleges/Technical Institutes will be determined solely by that institution.
3. Determination of high school course work satisfaction by virtue of courses taken at Community Colleges/Technical Institutes will be made by the principal of the high school, subject to State Board Policy.
4. Percentage of students, as of the official 9-12 fall enrollment, enrolled at Community Colleges/Technical Institutes shall comply with the North Carolina Administrative Code.
5. The principal of the student's high school is responsible to insure compliance with the North Carolina State Administrative Code and Local Board Policy.
6. The off-campus institute is responsible for notifying the high school principal concerning student progress, including withdrawal or course completion.

Priorities (Listed in Rank Order)

1. Those students seeking course work which will satisfy the requirements for graduation from high school.
2. Those students seeking course work which will facilitate entry into a post-secondary program of study or will develop skills which enhance employability immediately after graduation from high school.
3. Those students seeking course work for enrichment purposes only.
