Reproductive Health and Safety Education Permission Form

In accordance with Transylvania County Board of Education Policy IGB and as required by law 1 2 beginning in grade 7 through grade 9, reproductive health and safety education must be taught to students. The information provided will be **age-appropriate** on sexual abstinence until 3 marriage, STDs, the human reproductive system, effective contraceptive methods for preventing 4 pregnancy and awareness of sexual assault and sexual abuse. 5 6 7 The materials will be taught in two units during regular health education classes (separated by boys and girls). A parent/guardian must provide a signed permission form for his/her child to 8 participate in either or both units. If a parent/guardian does not provide a signed permission 9 form for participation, the student will be given an alternate assignment. 10 11 **Unit One: The Abstinence-Based Unit** will include the following topics: 12 13 Teaches abstinence from sexual activity outside of marriage is the expected standard 14 A. for all school-age children. 15 16 Presents techniques and strategies to deal with peer pressure and offering positive В. 17 reinforcement. 18 19 C. Presents reasons, skills and strategies for remaining or becoming abstinent from 20 21 sexual activity. 22 D. Teaches abstinence from sexual activity as the only certain means of avoiding out-of-23 wedlock pregnancy; sexually transmitted diseases when transmitted through sexual 24 contact, including HIV/AIDS; and other associated health and emotional problems. 25 26 E. Teaches that a mutually faithful, monogamous heterosexual relationship in the 27 context of marriage is the best lifetime means of avoiding sexually transmitted 28 diseases, including HIV/AIDS. 29 30 F. Teaches the positive benefits of abstinence until marriage and the risks of pre-marital 31 sexual activity. 32 33 G. Provides opportunities that allow for interaction between the parent or legal guardian 34 35 and the student. 36 37 H. Provides factually accurate biological or pathological information that is related to the human reproductive system.

42	A.	Teaches about sexually transmitted diseases (STDs). Instruction shall include how		
43 44		sexually transmitted diseases are and are not transmitted, the effectiveness and safety of all federal Food and Drug Administration (FDA) approved methods of reducing		
45		the risk of contacting sexually transmitted diseases, and information on local		
46		resources for testing and medical care for sexually transmitted diseases. Instruction		
47		shall include the rates of infection among pre-teens and teens of each known STD and		
48		the effects of contracting each transmitted disease. In particular, the instruction shall		
49		include information about the effects of contracting the Human Papilloma Virus,		
50		including sterility and cervical cancer.

52	B.	Teaches about the effectiveness and safety of all FDA approved contraceptive		
53		methods in preventing pregnancy.

55	C.	Teaches awareness of sexual assault, sexual abuse and risk reduction. The instruction		
56		and materials shall:

58		1. Focus on healthy relationships;		
59		2. Teach students what constitutes sexual assault and sexual abuse, the causes of		
60		those behaviors, and risk reduction;		
61		3. Inform students about the resources and reporting procedures if they		
62		experience sexual assault or sexual abuse; and		
63		4. Examine common misconceptions and stereotypes about sexual assault and		
64		sexual abuse.
