The Transylvania County Board of Education expects student behavior to reflect respect and consideration for the rights of others.

A student's behavior, whether it be in class, in school, on school grounds, at a school-related function, or in the community, is of legitimate concern to school officials if the behavior poses a threat to the well-being of other students and/or school personnel or interferes with the educational process.

A copy of this policy and its sanctions will be given to each student and parent.

Parents and students will be notified that compliance with this policy is mandatory.
