G.S. 115C-391(b) states: "The principal or assistant principal of a school may suspend a student who willfully violates rules of conduct for 10 days or less. Students are permitted to take any quarterly, semester or grading period examinations missed during the suspension period."

There is no appeal process in the specific statute related to suspensions of less that 10 days. However, G.S. 115C-45 provides a general appeal process: "An appeal shall lie from the decision of all school personnel to the appropriate board of education." Appeals of suspensions for less than 10 days are made through the superintendent or his designee.
