STUDENT EXPULSION FILE: JGE

Pursuant to North Carolina General Statute 115C-391(d), as amended by Chapter 386 of the 1995 Session Laws, the Transylvania County Board of Education may expel a student who is at least 14 years old and whose behavior indicates that the student's continued presence in school constitutes a clear threat to the safety of other students or employees.

The Board's decision to expel a student shall be based on clear and convincing evidence. Prior to ordering the expulsion of a student, the Board shall consider whether there is an alternative program available that may provide educational services for the student.

An expelled student may apply to the School Board for readmission, but the application may not be made before the July 1 that is at least six months after the Board's expulsion decision.
