CEP - COMMUNITY ELIGIBILITY PROVISION

- Means for severe need schools or districts to offer meals at no cost to all students
- Identified Student Percentage (ISP) must be 25% of enrollment to qualify for CEP. ISP is comprised of students directly certified through food assistance programs, Medicaid, Homeless, Migrant and Runaway.
 - April 1, 2023 Data TCS was 50.96%
- Multiplier of 1.6 is multiplied by the ISP to determine what the reimbursement percentage will be.
 - $50.96\% \times 1.6 = 81.53\%$ of meals served are reimbursed at the free rate (\$4.35/lunch) and 15.63% will be reimbursed at the paid rate (\$.50/lunch).
 - This would realize a loss of \$3.85 per meal for 18.47% meals served.
- The higher a district's ISP and the participant increase in participation will determine the financial viability of CEP.



TRADITIONAL VS CEP REIMBURSEMENT

- TCS implementation year for CEP was 2023-2024.
 - 50.96 ISP
 - 25% increase in lunch participation due to meals at no cost
- Traditional Reimbursement- SY 22-23 total reimbursement: \$1,340,671.72
- CEP Reimbursement SY 23-24 reimbursement through April 2024: \$1,550,776.61



SCHOOL YEAR 2024-2025 PLAN

- April 1, 2024 Data TCS is 52.73% (Increase from 2023 data)
 - $52.73\% \times 1.6 = 84.37\%$ of meals served are reimbursed at the free rated (unavailable) and 15.63% will be reimbursed at the paid rate (unavailable).
- Renew up to 4 years
- SY 2024-2025 Breakfast and Lunch Meals will be at no cost to all students Pre-k through 12th grade
