WHEREAS, it is estimated that the use of school buses saves over 65 million gallons of fuel statewide each year compared to individual family cars; and

WHEREAS, school bus drivers travel thousands of miles each school year, navigating rural roads, neighborhood streets and multi-lane highways to deliver students to their schools and homes safely; and

WHEREAS, weather and road conditions, student passengers and other motorists can create special challenges to school bus drivers as they carry out their duties; and


WHEREAS, the State of North Carolina salutes and appreciates school bus drivers and recognizes the valuable contributions they make to public education and student safety; and
