The State Board of Education Defined 16 criminal acts that are to be reported to law enforcement:

- Homicide
- Assault resulting in serious bodily injury
- Assault involving the use of a weapon
- Rape
- Sexual offense
- Sexual assault
- Kidnapping
- Robbery with a dangerous weapon
- Taking indecent liberties with a minor
- Assault on school personnel
- Bomb threat
- Burning of a school building
- Possession of alcoholic beverages
- Possession of controlled substance in violation of law
- Possession of a firearm or powerful explosive
- Possession of a weapon
