Any student not in class on time will be considered TARDY. Classroom tardy policy is as follows: Students will be given a detention assignment at the second (2 nd) tardy offense. At the third (3rd) tardy, the student will complete a Written Notice of Consistent Classroom Tardiness that must be signed by the student and parent. The teacher will issue the notice upon the third tardy and expect it returned, with signatures, the next school day. Refusal by a student to return the signed notice will be considered defiance. Defiance will be handled by referral to administration wherein the student will be required to attend Saturday School of that week. Noncompliance with Saturday School attendance results in overnight suspension and/or discipline for insubordination as

described in district behavior policy. Additional tardies will result in additional consequences including the student being added to a 'No Additional Activities' list as per Brevard Middle School I Tardy to School Policy. 1st Tardy = Verbal Warning 2nd Tardy = Detention Assignment 3rd Tardy = Notice of Consistent Classroom Tardiness with Written Reasons (and detention at teacher's discretion). This notice needs to be signed by the parent and student and
returned the next school day. 4th Tardy = Office referral and assigned Saturday School of that week 5th Tardy/Non Compliance with Saturday School Assignment = Overnight Suspension (student not allowed to attend school until escorted by parent for attendance meeting)
Note: This tardy procedure is continued until the end of the 9 weeks period at which time all tardy counts would start again at zero.
