8	Specific consequences for students who are chronically tardy to school/class.	Edited	Students with 9 or more tardies to class will not be allowed to attend class without a conference with the principal and parents. Excessive tardies to class may result in withdrawal from class for the remainder of the semester.
12	Student illness/medication: Students who have minor discomfort or illness and request to leave school.	Edited	The district nurse advises that students who have a temperature in excess of 100 degrees should be sent home from school. To reduce the number of students who leave school due to minor illness or discomfort, the district nurse indicates students should return to class unless a temperature of 100 degrees is determined, or other severe symptoms of illness (i.e.vomiting)
19	Fighting: Clarification of consequences	Edited	More serious consequences, including long-term suspension may occur on the first offense or subsequent offenses depending on the severity of the offense.
22	Wireless communication: Clarification on policy as it applies to DRS campus	Edited	Since DRS does not have lockers, students are prohibited from having electronic devices on campus during the school day unless granted permission by principal or designee. Students who drive to school may lock electronic devices in cars.
22	Use of telephone in office	New	Periodically, students request to use the office phone to call parents to arrange for transportation, or other personal needs. While we will make every reasonable attempt to assist in contacting parents, no student will be allowed to use the phone without permission from a staff member. To prevent students from missing instructional time, office staff will notify parents when appropriate while the student remains in class.
