
Winter Update on the TCS Online Learning Path

What is the TCS Online Learning Path (OLP)?



The TCS Online Learning Path was created in July 2020 to meet the needs created by Covid 19. This path allowed students to learn from their homes, 5 days per week.

This optional learning platform looked across the entire school system as ONE. Teachers at PFE may teach students from RES, BES, etc. Teachers at BHS may teach RHS students online and a course in person at BHS.

A Spring student application was sent out in October and November. Students that signed up for the spring will remain in OLP for the remainder of the school year.

TCS Elementary OLP: Quick facts

*Fall OLP Teachers: 22 teachers, 100% OLP
*Fall OLP Student Enrollment: 470 students
*Spring OLP Teachers: 14 teachers; 100% OLP
*Spring OLP Student Enrollment: 344 students
*A typical elementary day in the TCS OLP:

8:30am-12:00pm (Live, interactive instruction. This might include small groups, independent work, 1:1 conference, interventions, etc. All lessons are recorded and posted for later access).

TCS Middle School OLP: Quick Facts

*100% Fall OLP Teachers: 7 teachers (a blend of OLP and F2F)
*Fall OLP Student Enrollment: 310 students
*Spring OLP Teachers: 7 teachers (a blend of OLP and F2F)
*Spring OLP Student Enrollment: 186 students; 100% OLP
*A typical middle school day in the TCS OLP:

8:30am-12:00pm (Live, interactive instruction. This might include small groups, independent work, 1:1 conference, interventions, etc. All lessons are recorded and posted for later access).

TCS High School OLP: Quick facts

*Fall OLP Teachers

-100% online, partial online and face-to-face, blended

*Fall OLP Student Enrollment

-264 students

*Spring OLP Teachers

-Partial online and face-to-face, blended

*Spring OLP Student Enrollment

-123 total students: 97 BHS & 26 RHS

*A typical high school day in the TCS OLP

-Similar to a typical day of face-to-face students; students log in to the class at the scheduled time (i.e. World History, 1st block, 8:05)


-IF the class is completely OLP students meet 4 days per week for 45 minutes of instruction for each class

-IF the class is blended, students will log in during A day or B day and participate as if they were seated in the class

Tentative Goals/Ideas:

- K-8 OLP school for 21-22 (numbers TBD)
- 9-12 continue along a similar path based on student need and OLP enrollment
- Eliminate "blended" classes if possible
