Drug Testing

- 4 tests completed for 2019-20
- 225 total students tested in grades 6-12
- 2156 total students in the selection pool
- We tested 10% of the selection, and 2% were positive.

Athletics

- NCHSAA and Pardee have guidelines and recommendations that we are currently following.
- Phase 1- 2 weeks starting June 15th
 - Workouts are not mandatory and parents must sign a informed consent form before their athlete can participate.
 - Physicals extended, but high risk issues (asthma, heart, etc.) require further clearance from a healthcare provider.
 - Face coverings and a water bottles are required to participate.
 - 25 People per venue, this includes the coaches and athletes.
 - One 90 minutes session per day with no more that 60 mins of cardio
 - 4 workouts per week
 - Weight room is closed
 - Health screening, social dististaning, and sanitizing guidelines are being implemented by our Athletic Trainers.
