#### **Bermuda Grass recommendations**

<u>Climate conditions</u>-Bermuda grass needs warm humid temperatures for ideal growth. Too much rain/watering also hinders growth

<u>Recommended Usage</u>- Bermuda grass can withstand anywhere from 45-60 contest/activities in a calendar year, provided that recovery time and conditions are provided to allow the grass to grow and fill in

## **Cost Per Year to Maintain the Field**

These are estimates for a year with the purpose of having a field that is presentable and representative of Brevard High School

- Paint and Seed : 2013/14 \$9,962.31 [Not counting Spring sports]
- Maintenance on Machines (Paint Machines, 2 Mowers, Tractor, and Gang Reels)
- Top Dressing : \$8,000-\$9,000 (recommended every 2 years)
- Sprigging the field : \$7,000 (recommended every 2 years or heavy used areas)
- Labor and Time : 20 hrs a week average (Mowing, Painting, spreading seed, etc.)
- Irrigation : \$450 (Irrigation Head cost \$150 a piece; replace 2 or 3 a year)

\*Weather is a factor: It cost the system \$19,200 in (2009) in addition to normal cost due to heavy rain and normal use.

## **Turf Proposal**

Medallion Turf Company Mooresville, NC

\$493,000-\$500,000 total for the turf project

#### Warranty

#### The field will be under full warranty for 8 yrs

#### The Life Expectancy of the turf is 12-13 yrs.

#### In House Financing Option

**Transylvania County School Board- \$246,500** 

Transylvania County Commissioners- \$246,500

It is our plan that the County Commissioners would loan the total amount of the project at \$493,000 to the School Board up front and allow the Transylvania County School board pay the County Commissioners back at a rate of \$24,650 a year over a 10 year period at 0% interest in order to cover the school board's half of the project

#### Investment on Behalf of BHS Athletics

-Brevard High School Athletic Department will dedicate \$20,000 per year to a "re-turf fund" to cover the cost of resurfacing the field in 12-14 yrs (life-expectancy)

-This will ensure that the high school field become self sufficient and is a one time cost to the school board and county commissioners
